Beverly High School is a four-year public high school enrolling approximately 1300 students in 2019-2020, including 287 seniors. Accreditation is through the New England Association of Schools and Colleges and the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

## Curriculum:

Levels represent the different academic standards offered in courses: Advanced Placement/Honors, College Preparatory and Unleveled. AP and Honors are the most challenging courses. College preparatory courses are designed to prepare students for higher education or technical schools. Courses without the designation of CP/Honors/AP are not counted when calculating GPA. Beverly High School operates on a 4x4 Block Schedule. All courses are 83 minutes and are on alternating day schedule.

Beginning in the 2019-20 school year, students must pass a course with a D (60). Courses taken 2016-2019 required a D(63) to pass. Courses taken during or prior to the 2015-16 school year required a D- (60) to pass. Failing grades are entered on transcript and included in GPA calculations even if the course was repeated or taken in summer school.
